- Rehabilitation of sick, injured and orphaned wildlife

Comment

There is currently no provision in the Wildlife Act for the rescue, rehabilitation and release or ongoing captive care options for dingoes. The dingo remains "Threatened" in National Parks, on private property and should have special permissions included for such activities. Public, and our surveys shows this to be in excess of 85%; who do not want to see every rescued dingo killed should have a legitimate option to follow without being outside regulations. Those who undertake such activities in good faith should not be treated as criminals. It should also be recognised that dingoes require advanced care and treatment and that there are some current carers who could be permitted to undertake such work.
