## Walking and cycling

We're building a walking and cycling path along Hall Road to make it easier and safer for you to walk and cycle locally.

New walking and cycling paths will be built along sections of Hall Road between McCormicks Road and Cranbourne-Frankston Road, which will connect to existing paths in the area.

These paths will make it easier and safer for you to walk and cycle around your local area, better connecting pedestrians and cyclists to schools, local shops and public transport.

### What will we be doing?

We'll build a 3-metre-wide walking and cycling path along the south side of Hall Road between McCormicks Road and Bradman Drive. This will connect to the existing walking and cycling path between Bradman Drive and Cranbourne-Frankston Road.

We'll also build a 3-metre-wide walking and cycling path along the north side of Hall Road between Western Port Highway and Bradman Drive, connecting to the existing path that extends to Evans Road. This will better connect the community and encourage walking and cycling in the local area.

### Features and benefits

The new walking and cycling paths will:

- encourage people to walk and cycle more within the local area
- be a safe off-road travel option, connecting to other paths in the area
- provide safe access to public transport
- be wide enough to accommodate pedestrians and cyclists
- provide better connectivity to local shops, local schools and the growing areas on either side of Hall Road
- be a continuous path on the south of Hall Road from McCormicks Road to Cranbourne-Frankston Road.

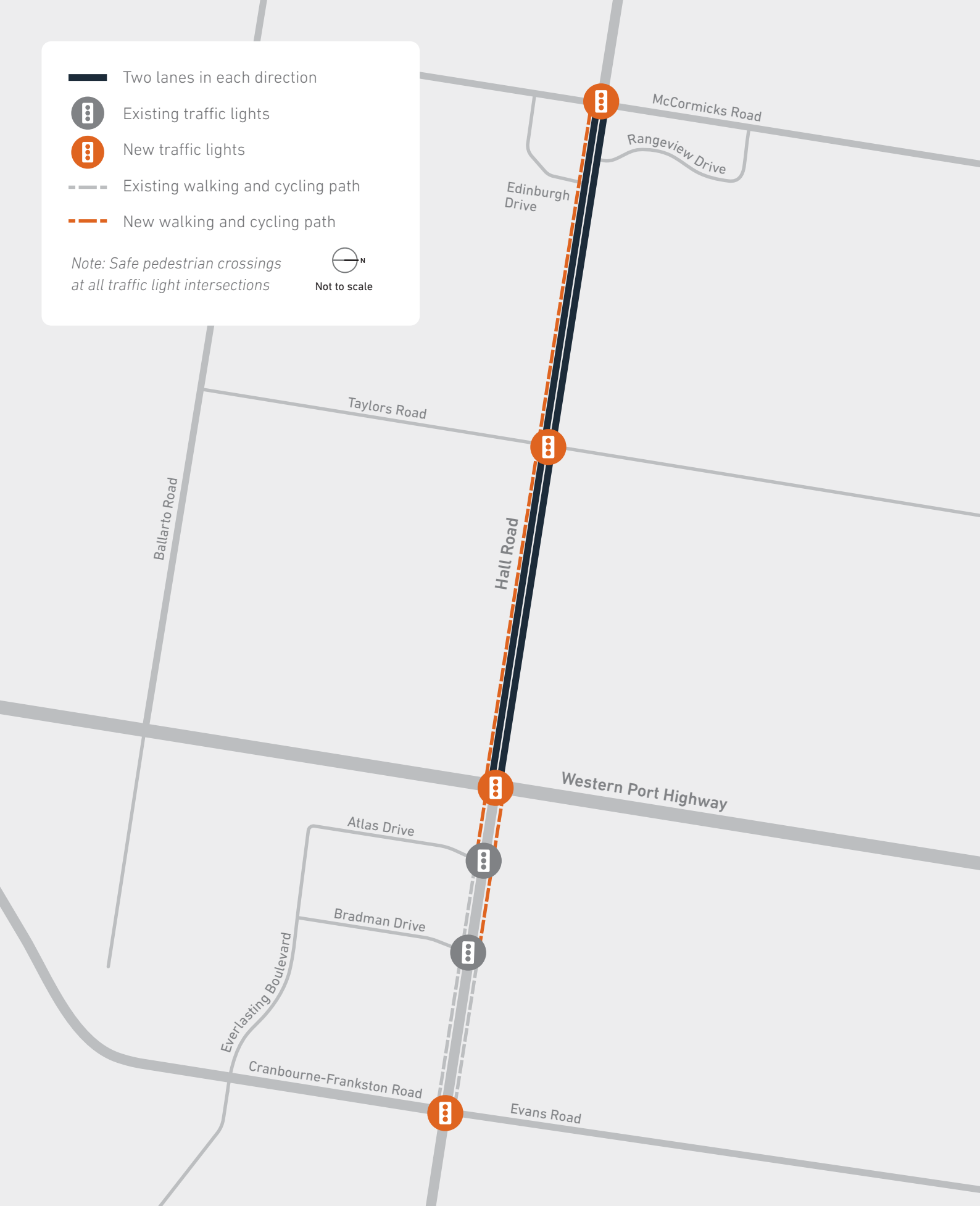
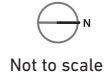
