Comments: To whom it may concern, RE: OBJECTIONS TO TRAM BRIDGE I am writing this email in response to the proposed tram bridge through the Yarras edge community. Firstly I would like to highlight that we are not against future development in our community, however, we feel that this bridge and tower will have a negative impact on us and our neighbouring residents lives. Our main concerns with this development are, but not limited to; the marina closure, privacy and noise issues in 7 towers. We feel that the approval of this development will impact on the visual amenity of the Yarras Edge precinct as well as the noise impact from the trams. As we currently have our boat moored in the Marina, which is one of the reasons we built at the Yarras Edge precinct. We will be greatly affected by the loss of access to the Yarra river, not to mention the impact on our property and moorings, which we have leased until 2030.
