<b>How do you think we should improve the FFG Act?</b>	<p>The Eldorado Cemetery has a small section of land classed as a nature reserve approx. one acre of land next to the cemetery on Cemetery Road Eldorado. The Eldorado Cemetery Trust wish to reclaim this section of land to again join onto the cemetery grounds to enhance the cemetery so that we will have surveyed future interment area plus retain some of the nature reserve and its trees. The reserve was fenced originally by the Eldorado Cemetery Trust and is not controlled or has access to the public because of fencing which was done many years ago. This section of land is more of a fire hazard to the cemetery and is not maintained by Parks Victoria or any other Government Department, it is just a very small section of land that joins onto the cemetery boundary. The Cemetery Trust would manage this small reserve if it was given back to the cemetery and clean it up so that visitors could walk through the grounds and access the reserve and also extend our interment area with our intent to maintain an environment that visitors to the cemetery will be able to use.</p>
