Comments: I would like to express my support of the draft Land use Framework Plan. Additionally, I have always seen Manningham as having great potential when it comes to the Arts. We are privileged and have Heide in our region, as well as the Heidelberg School Artists Trail, we have MC2 and have significant sculptures at our major entry points. We are adjacent to a very Arts oriented community Nillumbik. The opportunity I see is to develop Manningham from an Arts perspective and have Manningham known as the 'Gateway to the Arts'.
