I have a vested interest in the Delivery Share review.

A review of this flawed and inequitable system is long overdue and I applaud the current government in undertaking this process.

I am however sceptical that the views of the farming community will hold any sway against that of agencies that to date have not listened to one bit of the conversation or attempted to rectify any identified issues.

It takes a brave government to admit they implemented a flawed policy and I am encouraged that a brave government will take action to rectify and admit their error.

The answer to all issues raised with the Delivery Share system is that it must be made flexible for customers and valuable to their enterprise. This will make it tradable. Once Delivery Share are tradable the market will take care of the rest.

The two main issues are:

The 270 multiplier which should be reduced to 100 by being linked to the delivery of water right within 100 days. I would be interested to know how many delivery share have been terminated by termination fee by customers.

A reduction in the termination free back to the annual free.

Customer consultation means you listen to all customers and have a discussion. Please hear their frustration.

I attach previous communications from my father as evidence of previous consultation and extreme frustration of a farmer that worked his land for over 50 years and struggled with the enormous financial legacy that the Delivery Share termination fee imposed upon him and the others within his community.
