Other comments	Consulting Surveyors Victoria (CSV) wishes to only comment on the proposed wording of the exemption related to Surveying in Clause 52.17-7 Table of Exemptions in the Draft VPP Clauses. CSV fully supports the inclusion of the limiting of clearing to the 'minimum extent necessary' and references to licensed surveyor and the Surveying Act 2004, but has a concern with the words 'by a licensed surveyor', as we believe this could be interpreted to restrict this exemption solely to a licensed surveyor, rather than allowing individual survey party members to operate under the exemption. We suggest these words should be replaced with 'under the direction and supervision of a licensed surveyor'. This wording is consistent with the wording in Section 58(2) of the Surveying Act 2004 (related to Powers of Entry), which states: 'A licensed surveyor, or a person acting under the direction and supervision of a licensed surveyor'. We believe that this minor change to the wording would provide significant clarity to the authorised exemption.
