I think that all native animals should be protected under the Act, including native ducks which are currently allowed to be shot for hunting. Native animals need to be protected from further habitat destruction by ending native forest logging in Victoria immediately. An independent regulator should be established to enforce the Wildlife Act with stronger penalties for offences. The aerial baiting of native dingoes should be stopped. 1080 poison should be banned and research and development should be funded to investigate the use of non-lethal alternatives. Kangaroos should be protected and killing them should stop immediately. Wildlife should not be considered as property, the law should recognise inherent rights in wild animals (wildlife and nature as legal subjects). The Act should not support commercial use of wildlife whether that is by Traditional Owners and Aboriginal Victorians or others. Land owners should be held responsible for the protection and conservation of wildlife and wildlife habitat on their land. The Act should recognise sentience of all wildlife. The maximum penalties in the Act should be increased to further punish and deter offenders.

I am a hobby farmer, running a few cows, have chooks and grow vegetables and fruit trees in a sustainable way. I plant trees in lots of 50 to replace those that die or drop limbs and manage the paddocks for weed infestation. I am also a wildlife trained carer and protect any injured wildlife that I come across. I have been involved in protecting local kangaroos that a neighbour had a license to cull. Through FOI we saw the form that was poorly and wrongly written and yet it got approval. Further investigation revealed the many conflicts of interest and poor decision making in this process. My comments cover: All native animals should be protected under the Act, including native ducks which are currently allowed to be shot for hunting - I have about 30 on my dams at present
