Comments: My name is David Krynski (Director Victorian Yacht Charters) I am a business owner at Yarra's Edge (YE). The Fishermans Bend draft framework proposes a tram bridge over the Yarra River at YE. I am opposed to this bridge for the following reasons; • Marina viability • Loss of income • Traffic • Noise and visual pollution • Will need to relocate or close the business • Loss of income to the restaurants we take our customers to. • Loss of community Victorian Yacht Charters has been at Yarras Edge since 2005 when we were invited by Mirvac to take their residents out on a number of cruises. Since than we have established ties with a number of businesses in the area which benefit from our Cruise and dine and Bed and Breakfast packages. We currently have 3 boats here and bring approximately 40 to 50 people into the local area each weekend. This injects an income into the local business community which will be sorely missed if the tram bridge proceeds as we will need to re locate. In addition, we cannot think of a suitable place for relocation which gives us the same convenient access to the restaurants and amenities we have at Yarras Edge to run our business. For this reason, we will have to seriously consider shutting down our business. For all of these reasons, I strongly advise the Fishermans Bend Planning Review Panel to recommend that draft planning scheme amendment GC81 be opposed and to seek a more appropriate option to the transport needs of Fishermans Bend.
