

The Victorian Government is delivering new stations at Goornong, Huntly and Raywood to give people in these growing communities access to public transport close to where they live.

The new stations will be delivered as part of the Bendigo and Echuca Line Upgrade.

By coordinating the two projects, we can deliver efficiencies and minimise disruption to the local community.

The new Huntly Station has been fast-tracked by nearly a year and is targeted for completion in mid-2022.

The new stations at Goornong and Raywood are on track for completion in late 2021 and late 2022.

Rail Projects Victoria (RPV) is responsible for the planning and delivery of the project on behalf of the Victorian Government.


Goornong Station

The new station at Goornong will be located between the Midland Highway and the rail line in Goornong, to the west of Chute Street/Goornong-Barnadown Road.

The new Goornong Station will include:

- a single-sided platform on the south side of the rail line
- lighting, seating and shelter
- signage, CCTV and public address (PA) system
- car parking with lighting and CCTV.

Goornong Station is on track to be completed in late 2021.

Raywood Station

The new station at Raywood will be located to the east of the railway line adjacent to the Inglewood Street level crossing.

The new Raywood Station will include:

- a single platform on the east side of the rail line
- lighting, seating and shelter
- signage, CCTV and public address (PA) system
- car parking with lighting and CCTV.

Raywood Station is on track to be delivered in late 2022.





Huntly Station

The new station at Huntly will be located to the north of the railway line adjacent to the Wakeman Road level crossing.

The new Huntly Station will include:

- a single-sided platform on the north side of the rail line
- lighting, seating and shelter
- signage, CCTV and public address (PA) system
- car parking with lighting and CCTV
- a bus stop and two bus bays.



Huntly Station has been fast-tracked by nearly a year and is targeted for completion in mid-2022. Some vegetation will be removed to allow access to the new Huntly Station from Wakeman Road, subject to planning and environmental approvals.

The station has been designed to minimise the amount of vegetation that requires removal.
