Melbourne Airport Environs Safeguarding Standing Advisory Committee: Part B – Round table sessions on drafting

The Committee has now received remaining late submissions in response to its Issues and Options Paper. As previously advised, submissions have been published online at engage.vic.gov.au/airport-safeguarding-advisory-committee/submissions.

The Committee's focus now turns to the drafting of provisions included in the Issues and Options Paper. This process will be convened by roundtable discussion by video conference, commencing **Wednesday 25 August 2021**. The Committee has invited and gratefully accepted an offer of further technical assistance from Marcus Lane Group as the advocates for Brimbank City Council and Hume City Council who will host roundtable sessions with Zoom.

The Committee has received 28 formal requests from submitters to participate in roundtable sessions. To ensure discussions are structured and manageable, the Committee intends to group parties over three separate days as follows:

In its letter dated 8 July 2021, the Committee proposed to limit the scope of roundtables to discussion on aircraft noise and the specific drafting changes to the Planning Policy Framework. The Committee is aware that some parties will want to raise other issues. The Committee wants to avoid re-prosecuting matters already canvassed in the hearing but appreciates that some parties may wish to verbally expand on matters raised in submissions to the Issues and Options Paper beyond drafting changes. It will therefore allocate limited time to each party for opening statements, before opening the floor for discussion on drafting matters.
