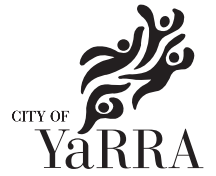


GENDER EQUALITY SNAPSHOT

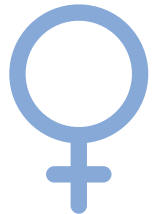
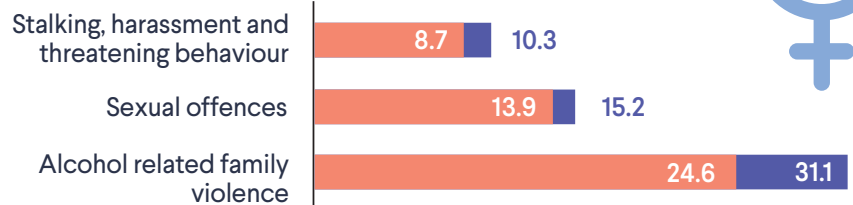
PER 10,000 PEOPLE IN YARRA
