



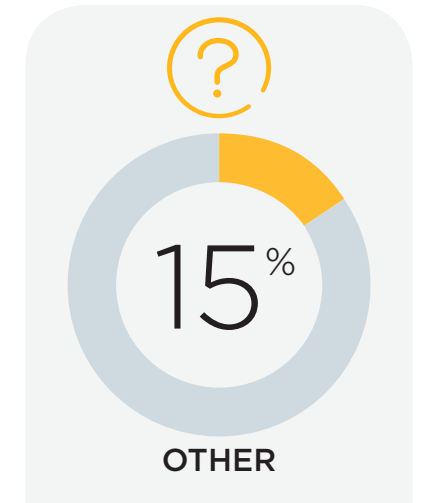
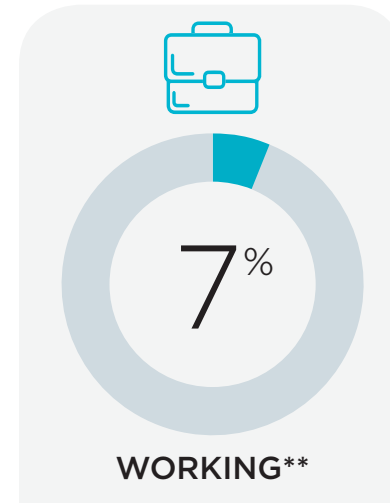
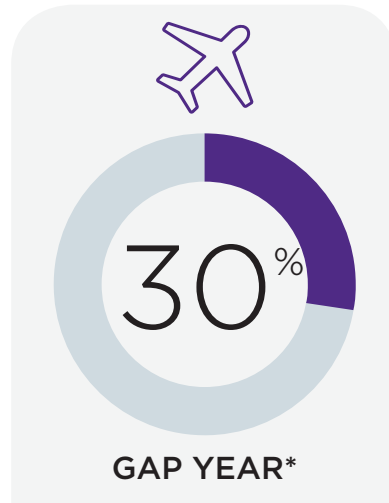
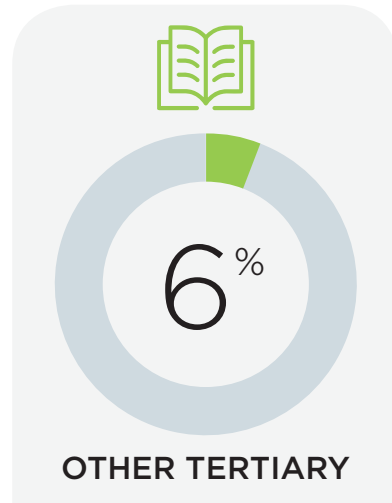
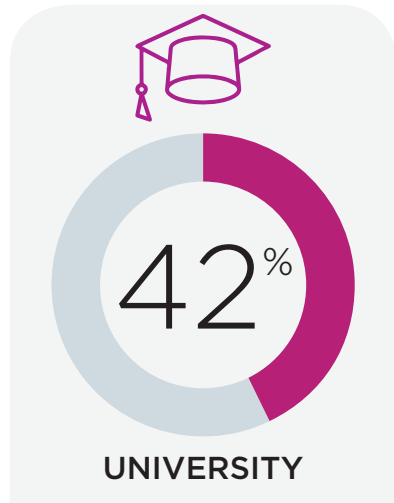
THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 2018: WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

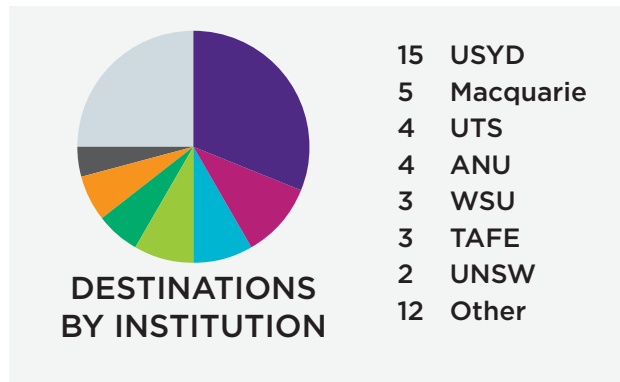
