<i>Leptospermum petersonii</i>	Lemon scented tea tree	Species in the genus <i>Leptospermum</i> are commonly known as tea trees and they are probably some of the best known of all Australian native plants. Tea trees are members of the widespread myrtle family. <i>Citrus australasica</i>	Finger lime	Indigenous to the rainforests of south-east Queensland and northern New South Wales. They come in a range of colours including black, green, red, pink, and yellow.
