Property Access Information for Colwyn Street and Aorangi Road residents (between Bateman Avenue and Wairakei Road)

Update: 31 July to December 2025

This notice provides information about accessing your property for the period between 31 July and December 2025. We advise reading the enclosed 'Work in your area' notice first for a full view of traffic impacts in the area throughout this period.

The last property access notice we sent covered the period from 30 June through to the end of July and contained information about our plan to use temporary traffic lights to support the management of resident traffic through the area during that time. We apologise that we did not go ahead with this, as we were unable to obtain the necessary approvals.

The following information outlines how you can access your street/property in the coming months.

31 July (end of day) to early August:

- While two-way traffic will be reinstated on Wairakei Road from 31 July (end of day), the road closure on Aorangi Road between Wairakei Road and Brookside Terrace will remain in place until early August.
- **Enter:** Continue to approach from the southern end of Aorangi Road or via either end of Brookside Terrace.
- Exit: You can also exit via the same routes.

Early August to December:

- Enter: With the southbound one-way system in place on Aorangi Road, from Wairakei Road to Bateman Avenue, you will need to approach Aorangi Road (south) from the north, via Wairakei Road. Colwyn Street can be accessed via a left turn only, approaching from the north using the Aorangi Road (south) one-way system.
- You will no longer be able to approach from the southern end of Aorangi Road, as the northbound lane will be closed.
- The road closures in place where Brookside Terrace intersects Aorangi Road are only expected to be required for six weeks. After this time, Aorangi Road residents between Brookside Terrace and Bateman Avenue can use Brookside Terrace to access the one-way system and reach their properties.
- Exit: You will need to exit the area using the Aorangi Road (south) one-way system, which ends at Bateman Avenue. To navigate north, east, south or west, use Bateman Avenue and Ilam Road, Clyde Road or continue along Aorangi Road.
 - After approximately six weeks, Brookside Terrace may also be an exit route for Aorangi Road residents located between Wairakei Road and Brookside Terrace, as well as Colwyn Street residents.
