

## Detour Advisory

### Domain Terrace road closure

<b>What</b>	Temporary road closure of Domain Terrace at Lincoln Road.
<b>Why</b>	We're upgrading the water and roading infrastructure on Lincoln Road between Wrights Road and Annex Road and sections of Halswell Road, Sylvan Street and Domain Terrace
<b>Where</b>	Domain Terrace, between Lincoln Road and Pony Lane.
<b>When</b>	From Monday 22 June – Friday 14 August 2026. 7am to 6pm (weather/site condition dependant)
<b>Contact</b>	The contractor working on behalf of Christchurch City Council is Isaac Construction Limited. Contact Jamie on 027 314 5534 or email communications@isaac.co.nz, Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm.

A temporary road closure will be in place at the intersection of Domain Terrace and Lincoln Road. This will allow for the installation of wastewater, stormwater, and services along Lincoln Road, across the entrance of Domain Terrace. We'll also install new wastewater infrastructure along Domain Terrace between Lincoln Road and Pony Lane.

To reduce disruption, we'll split the work into two halves.

#### Monday 22 June – Monday 20 July

- Domain Terrace will be closed between Lincoln Road and the entrance to Village Health Medical Centre.

#### Monday 20 July – Friday 14 August

- Domain Terrace will be closed between the entrance to Village Health Medical Centre and Pony Lane.

#### Traffic impacts (please see detour map on back):

- Vehicles travelling on Domain Terrace towards Lincoln Road will be detoured via Edinburgh Street and Lyttelton Street.
- Vehicles intending to turn onto Domain Terrace from Lincoln Road, will be detoured via Lyttelton Street.

#### General

- Please note traffic delays may occur
- Please follow all detour signage.
- There will be restrictions to on-street parking while we work in the area.
- Pedestrian access around site will be maintained. Please follow all signage and instructions from our team on site.
- Speed will be reduced to 30kph through the site.
- There may be increased noise, dust, and vibrations during the work.
