What we're doing

As part of our work to install a new underground power cable, we need to install cable ducts across the intersection of Hoon Hay Road and Sparks Road.

To do this work safely, Hoon Hay Road will be down to one lane southbound at the intersection with Sparks Road. Northbound traffic on Hoon Hay Road will be closed at the Sparks Road intersection.

Before this works starts, we will reopen both lanes of traffic on Sparks Road between Hoon Hay Road and Lyttelton Street. Sparks Road will be one-way travelling between Hendersons Road and Hoon Hay Road.

Traffic management

To do this work safely traffic management will be in place.

- Hoon Hay Road will be one lane southbound at the Sparks Road intersection.
- Northbound traffic on Hoon Hay Road will detour via Rose Street.
- No entry at Sparks Road for westbound traffic from Hoon Hay Road.
- Detour routes will be signposted.
- Sparks Road will be one-way travelling between Hendersons Road and Hoon Hay Road.

Cyclist access

Provisions for cyclists will be in place past the work site. Please follow all signs and instructions from our crew.

Pedestrian access

Pedestrian crossing points will be signposted. Please follow all signs and instructions from our crew.

How we install the cable

The new power cables will be pulled through the ducts we're installing. Once the ducts are in place, we will reinstate the road surface and reopen the road.

We will come back and thread the cable through the ducts and join the cable together at joint bays. Some traffic management will be in place when we come back to pull and join the cable.

Installing ducts allows us to speed up the cable laying process.
