Hydroseeding

Hydroseeding is an efficient method of planting grass by spraying a slurry mixture onto the soil. This mixture contains seed, water, fertilizer, mulch, and a bonding agent that helps it stick to the ground.

The process starts with grading and clearing debris, then applying the hydroseeding mixture using a specialized machine to evenly coat the area. The mulch retains moisture, shields the seed from erosion and sunlight, and supports faster germination and healthier growth.

On our construction sites, we use hydroseeding to reseed berms along the road, providing quick, cost-effective, and reliable results while helping control erosion and improve site appearance.
