Te Kaha Surrounding Streets – paver maintenance

What	Paver maintenance
Why	We're completing maintenance on sections of pavers on the intersections surrounding One New Zealand Stadium at Te Kaha.
Where	Barbadoes Street (at the intersections with Tuam Street and Cashel Street) and Madras Street (at the intersections with Tuam Street, Lichfield Street, and Cashel Street), Central City.
When	Sunday 1 March to Monday 2 March 2026: Cashel Street at Madras Street and Cashel Street and Tuam Street at Barbadoes Street Monday 2 March to Wednesday 4 March 2026: Lichfield Street at Madras Street and Tuam Street at Madras Street Monday to Friday, 7pm to 6am (weather/site condition dependent).

We'll need to close Cashel Street and Lichfield Street at Madras Street when working. To reduce disruption, **we'll work on one at a time.**

We'll begin work on Cashel Street at Madras Street from the evening of Sunday 1 March. When completed, we'll begin work on Lichfield Street at Madras Street.

Traffic impacts

- Cashel Street will close at the intersection with Madras Street.
- Lichfield Street will close at the intersection with Madras Street.
- Madras Street, near the work area, will be reduced to one lane.
- During the day, traffic management impacts will be removed.

We'll also be working progressively around the intersections of Tuam Street and Madras Street, Tuam Street and Barbadoes Street, and Cashel Street and Barbadoes Street. This work will require lane drops near the work area.

Details

- Temporary traffic management (road cones, signs and barriers) will be installed as a part of the works. Please follow all signage and instructions from staff.
- Please note traffic delays may occur and please follow the detour signage.
- There will be increased construction noise and vibration at times, and we will do our best to keep this to a minimum.
- Access to properties will be maintained throughout. Please advise if you have specific requirements e.g. medical visits, large deliveries, home help, and any planned works.
- Work will have no impact on any services such as electricity, telecommunication, and gas.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained around our work site. Our friendly staff will help people get around our site.
- A 30kph speed limit will be in place so we can keep our team and everyone safe.

We know this work can be disruptive and we appreciate your co-operation and understanding.

Night works

Noise	There may be increased noise, dust, and vibrations during work, but it shouldn't impact on your electricity, water, gas, or phone services.
Safety	Safety is our biggest priority, so, please keep children and pets away from worksites.
Bins	Please put your bins out as usual before 6am on your collection day. Our crew will move and return them if needed
