What are we doing?

We'll be working on Gardiners Road and Harewood Road (near the intersection with Breens Road/Harewood Road/Gardiners Road) on Wednesday 12 November and Thursday 13 November.

Investigation work is required to understand the location and condition of the existing underground services, as well as any potential clashes or risks to construction when we install the traffic signals at the Harewood Road/Gardiners Road/Breens Road intersection.

A second notice will be delivered next week prior to that work starting.

Traffic Impacts:

- During our working hours, traffic will be maintained in both directions with lane drops used to complete this work.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained and our friendly staff will help people get around our site.
- We will need to restrict some on-street parking, so we will place no parking cones out before we start work. We will aim to minimise this as much as possible.
- A 30km/h speed limit will be in place so we can keep our workers and everyone safe.

How do we carry out investigations?

The investigations will involve the crew undertaking potholing, and to do that, a hydrovac will be on site. This machine uses high-pressure water and a powerful vacuum to remove soil, which is noisy work.

The soil is then transferred to a debris tank to keep mess to a minimum. This is a safe, non-destructive and accurate way to remove soil or locate underground services, such as pipes, electrical cables and phone lines. Once the services have been located and documented, the potholes will be back-filled and resurfaced.

The work will not impact on any services, such as water, electricity, telecommunications and gas.

Noise	There may be increased noise, dust, and vibrations during work, but it shouldn't impact on your electricity, water, gas, or phone services.
Safety	Safety is our biggest priority, so, please keep children and pets away from worksites.
Bins	Please put your bins out as usual before 6am on your collection day. Our crew will move and return them if needed
