### Wairakei Road railway crossing – signal upgrades

<b>What</b>	Traffic management change to support upgrading the traffic signals at the railway crossing on Wairakei Road (near Jeffreys Road).
<b>Why</b>	The signals are at the end of their service life and need to be replaced.
<b>Where</b>	Wairakei Road railway crossing, Strowan.
<b>When</b>	2 March 2026 to 13 March 2026. Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm (weather/site condition dependent).
<b>Contact</b>	The contractor working on behalf of Christchurch City Council is Isaac Construction Limited. Contact <i>Communications Advisor</i> on 027 314 5534 or email communications@isaac.co.nz, Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm.

#### Details

To improve traffic flows around our site at the railway crossing on Wairakei Road, we'll be moving from a stop-go setup to a one-way system.

From Monday 2 March, Wairakei Road and Strowan Road near the work area will be one-way travelling towards Glandovey Road and Heaton Street.

#### Traffic impacts

- There will be no right turn from Normans Road onto Strowan Road.
- There will be no exit from Westholme Street onto Wairakei Road.
- There will be no entry from Wairakei Road onto Jeffreys Road.
- There will be no entry to Strowan Road from Glandovey Road/Heaton Street.




#### Information for road users

- Cyclists will need to merge with traffic through the site.
- We will temporarily remove on-street parking to allow space for the works. Local businesses in the area will remain open during this work.
- Please follow all signage and crew directions.
- A 30 km/h speed limit will be in place so we can keep our team and everyone safe.
- Temporary bus stops will be installed where existing stops may be affected. Signage will indicate where the bus stop has moved to. Please allow extra time.

#### Information for residents and businesses

- Access to properties and businesses for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists will be impacted at times. We'll aim to provide advance warning where possible.
- We will help people to get around the site. Please advise our team if you have specific requirements e.g. medical visits, large deliveries, home help or any planned works.
- The work will have no impact on any services such as electricity, telecommunications and gas.
- The timing of the work and certain activities will depend on the weather and the roads.
- Due to the nature of the intersection, night works may be required during this project. **Residents and businesses in the area will receive notification about this prior to work.**

<b>Noise</b>	There may be increased noise, dust, and vibrations during work, but it shouldn't impact on your electricity, water, gas, or phone services.
<b>Safety</b>	Safety is our biggest priority, so, please keep children and pets away from worksites.
<b>Bins</b>	Please put your bins out as usual before 6am on your collection day. Our crew will move and return them if needed
