## Nor'West Arc Cycleway

Ashgrove Terrace/Ferniehurst Street/Molesworth Place/Ferniehurst Bridge Intersection

**What** Footpath, kerb and channel, road construction, landscaping – including block paving

**Where** Intersection of Ferniehurst Street and Ashgrove Terrace and Molesworth Place

**When** Monday 26 October to Monday 30 November – hours of work Monday to Saturday, 7am – 6pm

**Why** To enable the construction of the Nor'West Arc Cycleway. Our network of cycleways are making it safer and easier for people to cycle. More people cycling eases the pressure on our roads.

### Details

#### Traffic Impacts

- Please note we will make a start on Molesworth Place from the 26<sup>th</sup> of October, this will not impact residents' access to Molesworth Place, access will be maintained via 1 or 2 lanes – depending on our work scope.
- Our work on the Ferniehurst Bridge will start from the 2<sup>nd</sup> of November, once the Woodbank-Ferniehurst intersection upgrade work is complete.
- Access to Cashmere Road via the Ferniehurst Bridge will be temporarily closed.
- Ferniehurst Street, between Molesworth Place and Ashgrove Terrace will also be temporarily closed.
- There will be some minor works undertaken on the corner of Molesworth Place and Ferniehurst Street. Two lanes for traffic will be maintained for the duration of the works.
- Ashgrove Terrace will be reduced to one lane, controlled by traffic lights either side of the bridge to enable the upgrade works.
- Detours will be in place for Ashgrove residents via Ashgrove Terrace, Fairview Street and then onto Cashmere Road.
- Detours for Molesworth Place, Ferniehurst Street, Woodbank Street, Karaka Place, Paikea Place and Palmside Street will be via Palmside Street, Rose Street, Hoon Hay Road and back onto Cashmere Road.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained but may change on a day to day basis, depending on works.

Works will have no planned impact on current power, telecommunication or gas services. However, the network is still fragile so please be prepared in case there is an unexpected service cut off.



All works are subject to favourable weather and on-site construction conditions.



Your rubbish and recycling will not change. Please put your bins in the normal spot by 5:00pm the night before collection and our crew will move and return them if needed.



Safety is our number one priority. Safety is your responsibility too. Stay clear and stay alert - keep children and pets at a safe distance from the work site.



Our standard work hours are Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00am to 6:00pm, however sometimes we will need to work at night to complete the work. We will notify you before we do this.
