Traffic Impacts

- Stage 1 of the works will involve traffic being controlled by a 3-way traffic light system to enable one lane access to Woodbank Street, Karaka Place and Paikea Place, via Palmside Street.
 - Road closure Ferniehurst Street, from 20
 Ferniehurst Street to Woodbank Street, closure in place from Monday 14 September, 6am to Monday 5 October, 7pm
 - Woodbank Street, Karaka Place and Paikea Place residents will need to use Palmside Street to access their properties
 - No parking from 4 Palmside Street to 1 Karaka Place
- Stage 2 of the works will involve traffic being controlled by a 3-way traffic light system to enable one lane access to Woodbank Street, Karaka Place and Paikea Place, via Ferniehurst Street.
 - Road closure Woodbank Street, from 6 Woodbank Street up to Ferniehurst Street. Closure in place from Monday 5 October, 6am to Saturday 31 October, 7pm
 - Road closure in conjunction with Stage 2 works – Ferniehurst/Woodbank intersection, daily closure (Monday to Friday – 9am to 4pm) from Monday 5 October to Saturday 31 October
- Pedestrian access will be maintained but my change on a day to day basis, depending on works.
- Access to residents' driveways will be maintained where practical, any work planned across a resident's driveway will be brief and at an agreed time.





Your rubbish and recycling will not change. Please put your bins in the normal spot by 5:00pm the night before collection and our crew will move and return them if needed.
