Investigation works – Wairakei/Strowan intersection

What	We'll be working on the road investigating the location of underground services.
Why	These works will confirm what is under the road and will help us to plan work in the area as part of work to support the Northwest water and traffic upgrades programme.
Where	The intersection of Wairakei Road and Strowan Road (at the rail crossing).
When	Sunday 25 and Monday 26 January 2026, 7am to 6pm (weather/site condition dependent).

Traffic along Wairakei Road and Strowan Road near the work area will be maintained in both directions under a stop/go system. There will be no access to Wairakei Road from Westholme Street. At times, there will be no left turn from Wairakei Road to Jeffreys Road. There may be some traffic delays.

Temporary traffic management (road cones, signs and barriers) will be installed as a part of the works. Please follow all signage and instructions from staff.

Please be on the lookout for changes in traffic management and follow the signs. A 30kph speed limit will be in place so we can keep our workers and everyone safe.

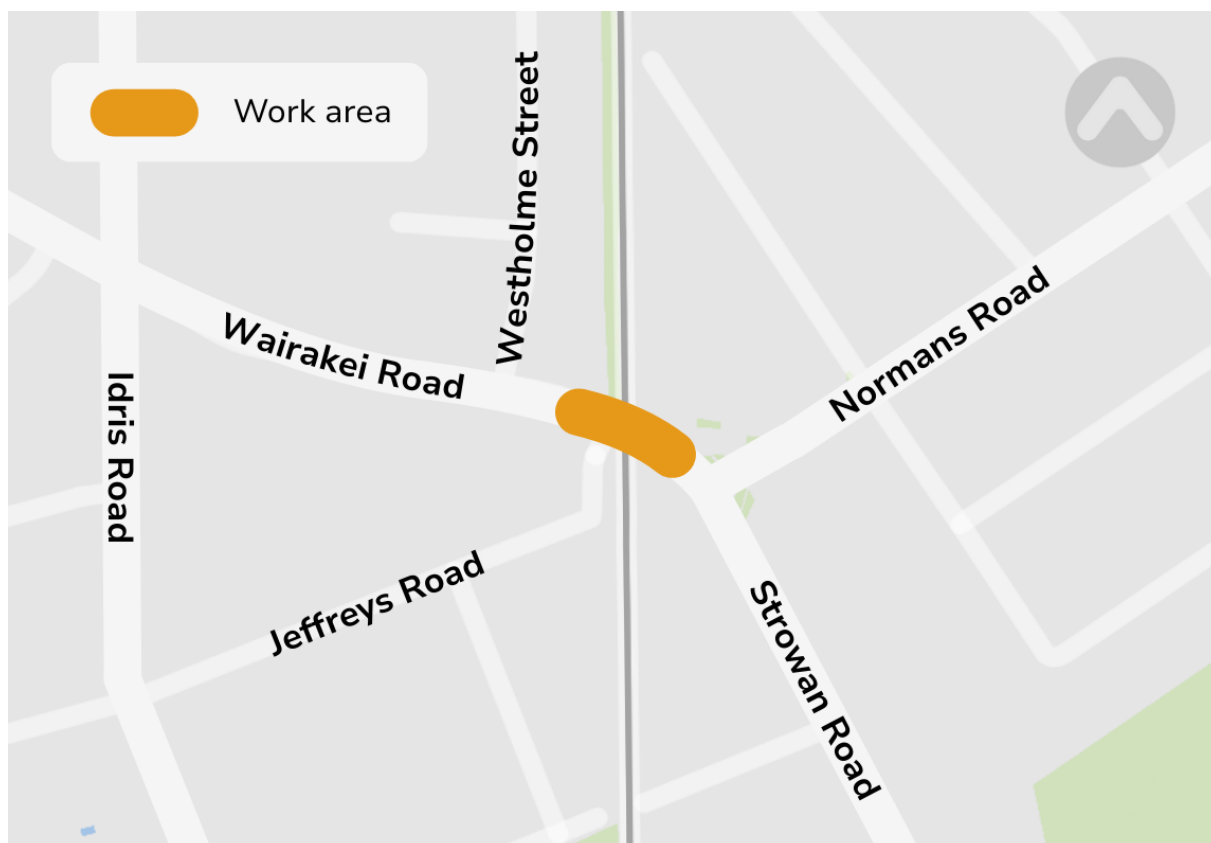
This work will create noise; our team will try to minimise noise where possible.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout. Please advise if you have specific requirements e.g. medical visits, large deliveries, home help, and any planned works. Work will have no impact on any services such as electricity, telecommunication, and gas.

Pedestrian access will be maintained around our work site. Our friendly staff will help people get around our site.

We know this work is disruptive, so we appreciate your patience and understanding.

Noise	There may be increased noise, dust, and vibrations during work, but it shouldn't impact on your electricity, water, gas, or phone services.
Safety	Safety is our biggest priority, so, please keep children and pets away from worksites.
Bins	Please put your bins out as usual before 6am on your collection day. Our crew will move and return them if needed
