FURTHER DETAILS

- Road or Rally tyres are allowed.
- Vehicles must be fitted with an appropriate fire extinguisher in good condition.
- Unless completed through WOLF or MA Portal online entry, at documentation, competitors must produce a valid and current:
 1. Motorsport Australia Competition License.
 2. Proof of Club Membership of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club.
 3. Log Book (if issued)
- Completed Entry & Self Scrutineering forms to be emailed to entriesCHDSCC@gmail.com
- The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR.
- The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Vehicles will be required to undergo a safety check before competing.
- Sausage sandwiches and cold drinks will be available for sale at lunchtime.
- A break for lunch is at the discretion of the Organisers.
- Mud, Tractor, or Winter tread tyres are NOT permitted without prior approval by the Venue, COC or Scrutineer.
- Cars must be adequately muffled. Sound testing may be carried out. <94db at 45 degrees at 500mm
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified
- Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian
- All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A and Group 4K of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- There are no EFTPOS facilities available at the venue.
- Phone service is unreliable at the venue, and the MA app may not operate for license display. A screenshot of your license details from the app is an acceptable alternative.

INTEGRITY

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
