QUICK DETAILS

- **Road or Rally tyres are allowed.**
 - **Mud, Tractor, or Winter tread tyres are NOT permitted** without prior approval by the Venue or COC.
 - Cars must be adequately muffled (sound level testing may be done at random throughout the event).
 - Vehicles must be fitted with an appropriate fire extinguisher in good condition.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 - Motorsport Australia Competition License
 - Club Membership of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club
 - Log Book (if issued)

FURTHER DETAILS

- All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A, Schedule B and Appendix Group 4K of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

INTEGRITY

Smoking Including e-cigarettes and vaping, and any naked flame is prohibited within (3) metres of any refuelling or defueling operation or within the paddock.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Integrity Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, and the Alcohol Policy apply to any activity authorised sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- While entries are accepted on the morning of the Event, we strongly recommend sending them in earlier. This helps us with catering, event organization, speeds up documentation and in some cases allows for more competitive runs/time on the day.
- There are no EFTPOS facilities available at the venue.
- The Raleigh Raceway canteen will have food and drinks available for sale at lunchtime. A break for lunch is at the discretion of the Organisers and expected around 12pm (once the previous course is completed). Drinks and a BBQ may also be available at the discretion of the organisers.
- Phone service is unreliable at the venue and the Motorsport Australia app may not operate for license display. A screenshot of your license details from the app is an acceptable alternative.
