

**ADVICE TO SPECTATORS
PLEASE READ**

- Spectators are directed to view the cars whilst standing within the markers indicating the limits of the controlled spectator area - spectating outside those areas is prohibited
 - Spectators must not stand in any "NO GO area" and must at all times stand behind the bunting and or barriers which mark the spectating area the instructions of the Spectator Marshalls **MUST BE OBEYED.**
 - The Chief Marshall has the power to have a stage postponed until the Spectator Point is controlled to their satisfaction.
- It is strongly recommended the spectator instructions are used to find your way around the rally.
There are risks such as meeting up with oncoming rally vehicles on a narrow road, many roads in areas used by the rally have wash-aways, collapsed bridges etc which are potentially hazardous for the driver. The main spectator route has been reviewed by the organisers and is considered the most appropriate route
- The use of Remote Piloted Aircraft (Drones) is regulated by the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations (Part 101). The unauthorised use of RPA over Sporting Events or Public Gatherings may lead to penalties up to \$9000. All unauthorised RPA operations over this venue will be reported to CASA. Anyone wishing to use an RPA should contact event organisers prior to attending the event


Times will be entered into the Chrissport system manually when cars return to the service park.

For Spectator Point D, E for Stage 6

For Point D, Cars will approach along a short straight before turning Left into a hidden bush turn, this point is hard to see from the competitor's point of view, DO NOT stand in the possible path of a over shooting vehicle.

For Point E, Cars will exit the bush from the left (with-in sight) then join a main road passing the spectator point at speed.

For Point F, Cars will have a fast downhill approach from the left, they will maneuver to the right around the cross road signage then turn Very Hard LEFT then immediate RIGHT to continue along Coopernook forest way, to the right.
