

**ADVICE TO SPECTATORS
PLEASE READ**

- Spectators are directed to view the cars whilst standing within the markers indicating the limits of the controlled spectator area - spectating outside those areas is prohibited
 - Spectators must not stand in any "NO GO area" and must at all times stand behind the bunting and or barriers which mark the spectating area the instructions of the Spectator Marshalls **MUST BE OBEYED.**
 - The Chief Marshall has the power to have a stage postponed until the Spectator Point is controlled to their satisfaction.
- It is strongly recommended the spectator instructions are used to find your way around the rally.
There are risks such as meeting up with oncoming rally vehicles on a narrow road, many roads in areas used by the rally have wash-aways, collapsed bridges etc which are potentially hazardous for the driver. The main spectator route has been reviewed by the organisers and is considered the most appropriate route
- The use of Remote Piloted Aircraft (Drones) is regulated by the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations (Part 101). The unauthorised use of RPA over Sporting Events or Public Gatherings may lead to penalties up to \$9000. All unauthorised RPA operations over this venue will be reported to CASA. Anyone wishing to use an RPA should contact event organisers prior to attending the event

For Spectator Point “B” Herons Creek Stage 2

Drive distance 20 km, Travel Time allow 25 minutes


First Car Due aprx Stage 2 – at 9:55am

From Service Park.

1. Travel East 600m Turn Left Burrawan Forest Drive
2. Travel 650m then Turn Right Burrawan Forest Drive
3. Travel 80m Turn Right (South) Onto the Pacific Motorway M1
4. Travel 9klms Taking the Bago Road turn off,
5. Turn across the Pacific Motorway Toward Herons Creek, Bago Road.
6. Travel 200m and take the exit to Ron Banks Road
7. Travel 1.9klms turn right under the railway line
8. Travel 250m Turn right onto Herons Creek Road
9. Travel 400m Turn right onto Blackbutt.
10. Travel 2.0klms turn left onto Blackbutt Road
11. Travel 2.9klms over the one lane bridge

Spector point is to the right aprx 500m, Park your car to one side of the road to allow emergency access if required.

Cars will approach along a short straight before turning Very hard right and then heading away from the Spectator Point.



For Spectator Point “C” Internal Break Stage 4

Drive distance 15 km, Travel Time allow 20 minutes

First Car Due approx. Stage 4 – at 12:35 pm

From Service Park at The Hastings Motorcross grounds.

- 1 Travel East 600m Turn Left Burrawan Forest Drive
- 2 Travel 650m then Turn Right Burrawan Forest Drive
- 3 Travel 80m Turn Right (South) Onto the Pacific Motorway M1
- 4 Travel 9klms Taking The Bago Road turn off,
- 5 Travel 450m Turn across the Pacific Motorway Toward Herons Creek, Bago Road.
- 6 Travel 400m at the roundabout take the second exit to Bago Road toward WAUCHOPE
- 7 Travel 650m Turn right
- 8 Travel 2.2klms to the spectator point.

Park your car to one side of the road to allow emergency access if required. Please stand behind the bunting tape and follow the instructions of the Spectator Marshalls.
