These Supplementary Regulations apply specifically to this Event and they are to be read in conjunction with the “*Southern Cross Rally Series Documents*”.

This layout style has been created to present a cleaner uncluttered layout and to generally avoid duplicating regulations that appear in the “*Series Documents*”.

Some Regulations will show “*Refer to*” and some may be duplicated specifically to highlight them.

1 ADMINISTRATION

EVENT DETAILS

- The Event will be a sanctioned gravel rally and shall be known as the 2026 Mini Bago Rally, hereinafter called “*the Event*”.
- The AMSAG Event Number is 2026-014
- The AASA Permit No. is **TBA**
The AASA Permit will be on display at Rally HQ during Rally Check In.
- The Event will be conducted under the National Competition Rules (NCR's) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA), the 2026 AMSAG Series Documents, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations and/or Bulletins that may be issued.
- The Event will be Organised by The Hastings Sporting Car Club (HSCC)
- The Event will be Promoted by both the Organizers and AMSAG Inc.
- The Event will be a closed Special Stage rally for members of AMSAG Inc. with results / points awarded counting towards the 2026 AMSAG Inc. Southern Cross Rally Series Championships.
- The Event will be conducted on gravel roads in the Mid North Coast area of NSW on 22nd August 2026.
- The Event will be a **DAYLIGHT ONLY RALLY**.

- An Officials information briefing will be held prior to the Event to fully explain...
 - 1) The importance of entering the "**POSITION on ROAD**" number onto each Competitor Road Card at **every** stage Start Control.
 - 2) The importance on gathering the "**POSITION on ROAD**" numbers from every Competitor Road Card and entering it onto **every** stage Finish Control Card and then ascertain that the numbers are running in numerical order.
 - 3) The importance of entering **CLEAR & LEGIBLE** figures on both the Officials Control Card and the Competitors Road Card.
 - 4) The importance for all MRC and Spectator Point officials to record each Car Number on the correct form as each competitor passes by.
 - 5) How to use the AMSAG two-way radio system.

Supplementary Regulations for this Event

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries open & close strictly as per the Event Programme and will be **limited to 50 ENTRIES** plus 5 Reserves.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse the entry of an entrant and / or crew member.

It is a condition of entry that competing vehicles display any advertising signage that may be provided by the Organiser

- **The Entry Fee shall be \$750.00 (GST inclusive).**

Included in the Entry Fee are Forestry Corporation fees, Officials levy, FIV Services, Public Liability Insurance and Personal Accident Insurance for both competitors.

- **Payment of the Entry Fee is required AT THE TIME OF ENTRY** and can be made by Direct Deposit, MasterCard or Visa via the secure payment portal found within the WOLF Sports portal.

Cheques will not be accepted.

Cash payments will not be received at Rally Check In.

Refund of an entry fee will only be paid if the Secretary of the Event is notified, in writing, prior to close of Rally Check In.

If unable to make payment by 5.00pm on the Wednesday prior to the Event you **MUST** contact the Secretary of the Event.

- **NOTE:**

**Your Entry will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver/Navigator have been nominated on the entry form and all required documents have been acknowledged or completed
and payment has been made in full.**

CHANGES TO ENTRY DETAILS

- Changes to entry details may be made prior to the close of Entries, as per the Event Programme, “on line” at Wolf Sports.

Thereafter, any changes are to be addressed in writing to the Event Secretary no later than the close of Rally Check In, as per the Event Programme.

PENALTIES

NO WHEEL SPIN STARTS

- **DEFINITION:**

A wheel spin start is defined as “Sustained loss of traction through wheel spin with no attempt to curtail the spinning before reaching the “GO” sign”.

Wheel SLIP is permitted but wheel SPIN is prohibited.

- As part of our agreement with Forestry Corporation, and in the interests of road damage and erosion control, a **NO WHEEL SPIN START** will be used at the start of all competitive stages.

A zone will be defined for drivers to adhere to.

- Any *CONTROL OFFICIAL* will be a Judge of Fact
 - Penalties apply for any breach/s

Any crew member NOT wearing neck to ankle & wrist clothing
WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START A STAGE.

Supplementary Regulations for this Event:

MISCELLANEOUS

- A 3k “Trip Check” will be provided.

It may be loose sheet format (available at Rally Check In) or it may be included in the Road Book.

- **Controls**

Controls will remain open until the departure of the Sweep vehicle (all Competitors must be accounted for before the Sweep shall commence).

Crews arriving at a Control AFTER it has closed shall be deemed to have missed that stage and may rejoin the Event at the start of a subsequent stage.

- **Timing & Scoring**

Departure times from stage Start Controls will be on the exact forward minute and arrival times at stage Finish Controls will be recorded to the current second.

Competitors Road Card/s will not be accepted by the scoring team if they are incomplete, ie no Start Time – no Finish Time or no Stage Time (Crew Calculation)

SERVICING of VEHICLES

- All servicing must be carried out within the service area for reasons of competitor and service crew safety.
- No service vehicle may drive on a competitive section during the running of the event.
- Refer to Section 5 “*RECOVERING A VEHICLE IN STAGES THAT ARE BEING REUSED*”.

- **Fuel Availability**

Fuel is available at the Port Macquarie Service Centre (Oxley Hwy and the Pacific Motorway roundabout) approx. 10 min North of the Service park

REMINDERS

- The lighting of fires in a forest at any time during the Event is strictly prohibited.
- **Alcohol**

As per AASA NCR's 2023 Schedule 3, item (a):-

- . A Competitor must not have a blood alcohol reading above 0.

SPEEDING IN TRANSPORT SECTIONS

- A hand held radar gun and/or a mobile radar unit may be in use at random locations during the Event.

The operator will be the sole Judge of Fact

- Times Allowed for Transport Sections are generous

there is NO reason for speeding in any Transport Section.

- Most transport sections are in outlying rural areas so please be aware of local drivers at all times.
- Penalties apply for any breaches.

OH&S ADVICE for Competitors & Service Crews

AMSAG wish to remind you that WorkCover NSW legislation deems a Rally Service Park to be a NSW Workplace.

Therefore, all workplace and OH&S practices that we observe every day in our regular working environment must also be observed and always practiced within the Service Park.

All personnel are asked to assess the risks associated with any practice that they are involved with and take action to minimise the potential injury to themselves and any other personnel.

As the Entrant, you have a Duty of Care for the health and safety of those people who might be affected by the activities of your team whilst at the rally.

These people may include the members of your competing crew, service crew, spectators and the public.

You may be held liable for the damage to property or injury to personnel should suitable assessment and risk minimisation practices not be followed.

Some examples of risks might be:

- The use of electrical power. High voltage cords and appliances should have a current safety inspection tag, and be used with a tagged safety switch.
 - When using jacks or jack stands, use equipment that is suitable for the job, and ensure that the vehicle is at all times properly secured. Getting underneath a vehicle that is only supported by a jack is serious risk, and should never be attempted
 - Re-fuelling may be conducted within your own work environment, however, a suitable and approved fire extinguisher should be nearby while refuelling. It is recommended that this extinguisher be manned during the re-fuelling operation. A notice of the danger of the re-fuelling.
 - Activity - from mobile phones, heat, cigarettes and other ignition sources – should be erected to warn all personnel not involved with the activity to stay well away.
 - To minimise the risk of damage to the environment, a liquid proof ground cover must be beneath the car during all servicing and re-fuelling operations. Be prepared to mop up any liquid spills immediately to avoid contamination of the ground, and report any such contamination to the attending official or Rally Control without delay.
 - Personal Safety Clothing should be worn by all personnel to minimise risk or injury. This may involve clothing with long sleeves, fire proof materials, gloves, ear protection and/or safety Goggles/Glasses.
 - Due to the hazards that can be associated to smoking, including the ignition of flammable liquids and gases within the service park, AMSAG strongly discourage smoking by all persons within the service park during the entire event.
 - You should consider the risk in all situations, and ensure that you manage all of your activities at the event and be prepared to demonstrate that you have considered these risks and put the appropriate safety measures in place.
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4 AMSAG ACCIDENT PROCEDURE

YOUR ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE AMSAG ACCIDENT PROCEDURE CONTAINED WITHIN THE “SOUTHERN CROSS RALLY SERIES DOCUMENTS”.

Please take the time to read and understand our “AMSAG ACCIDENT PROCEDURE”.

The “AMSAG ACCIDENT PROCEDURE” will be provided at the rear (before the back cover) of each event Road Book.

It will contain a form for the First Car on Scene to complete and hand to the Second Car on Scene if Rally Control has NOT been contacted.

Supplementary Regulations for this Event:

EXHAUST SYSTEM

- A vehicle with a broken exhaust shall not depart a Start Control until it has been repaired to the satisfaction of the Control Official.

UHF RADIO

- A reminder that ALL vehicles must be fitted with a **HARD WIRED** UHF radio. Radios **will** be checked at Scrutineering and at Rally Start.

Refer to “***Southern Cross Rally Series Documents***”, **5.2 SAFETY EQUIPMENT – VEHICLES** then **5.2.6 UHF Radio**.

If your radio does not work when you are requested to test it at Rally Start you will not be allowed to start until such time as your radio is fully operational.

If this occurs, you will then be starting out of “Seeded Order” and the appropriate penalty will be applied - refer to “*Southern Cross Rally Series Documents*”, 2.8.8 Penalties.

RECOVERING A VEHICLE IN STAGES THAT ARE BEING REUSED

- Prior to **anyone** (Service Crews, Competitors who have retired from the Event etc) entering a stage for any reason, a signed “*Permit To Enter A Stage*” form **MUST** be obtained from the Event Director giving permission to enter a stage **AFTER** a stage has been swept.
- On arrival at the authorized stage entry point (a stage Start Control, MRC or Finish Control) the Permit is to be given to the event official to show you have permission to enter a stage

NO FORM -- NO ENTRY!

- Before you can enter the stage the Official must contact Rally Control and receive permission to allow you to continue. He will then countersign the form and return it to you.
- When you are leaving the stage you **MUST** hand the form in to the Official at that location.

Note: For Stages that are NOT being rerun, a FORM is not required.

6 MISCELLANEOUS

Supplementary Regulations for this Event:

FINISHING, PLACINGS, AWARDS & PRESENTATION

A competitor must complete 100% of the course, in the vehicle they entered the Event, to be classified as a finisher.

Placings will be determined by least penalties incurred.

Trophies will be awarded as follows

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Classic Category Outright
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Open Category Outright
- 1st in each Class (excluding Outright placegetters)
- 1st Lady Driver
- 1st Lady Navigator
- The Brad Selmes Memorial Award - Best Presented Vehicle
- Ray Giffin Encouragement Award

Other awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organisers.

Presentation of Trophies will be held at the Service Park ASAP after the last car finishes.
