

# 1 EVENT SUMMARY

#### Article 1.1 - EVENT SUMMARY

THESE REGULATIONS ARE TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA MANUAL AND ANY FURTHER REGULATIONS, BULLETINS OR INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BY THE ORGANISERS.

- 1.1.1 The The Event is conducted under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Hillclimb Standing Regulations, the Motorsport Australia Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, these Supplementary Regulations, Further Regulations and any Bulletins or Instructions to competitors that may be issued.
- 1.1.2 Where there is any divergence between the Motorsport Australia Manual and these Event Supplementary Regulations, the Motorsport Australia Manual will take precedence.
- 1.1.3 The 2025 AMPL AUTO Willunga Hillclimb, hereinafter referred to as 'The Event'
- Will use electronic timing to 0.01 second.
- Is approved to run by Motorsport Australia.
- Will be a standalone Club Hillclimb event, and open to all Motorsport Australia affiliated car clubs. Single Event Membership to the Southern Districts Car Club is also available, contact the Event Secretary for details
- The Event is open to all vehicles that comply with Schedule A and B of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Category 1 vehicles are not permitted.
  - 1.1.4 The Motorsport Australia Permit Number authorising the Event is
  - 1.1.5 The Event will be approximately 2.69km long per heat with a minimum of 4 runs per car.
  - 1.1.6 Crews involved in accidents resulting in property damage are advised that they may be required to pay up to the first \$5000 of any claim to rectify such property damage. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at <a href="www.motorsport.org.au">www.motorsport.org.au</a>.

## Article 1.2 Sponsor/Official Rides:

During Breaks between competitive activities EVENT SPONSOR and EVENT OFFICIAL Appreciation rides may take place.

- 1.2.1 Participation in these activities will be by <u>invitation only</u> from the Event Organisers.
  All relevant Documentation relating to Passenger in Vehicle Experiences is to be completed by <u>ALL</u> Drivers and <u>ALL</u> Passengers prior to the activity commencing. This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.
- 1.2.2 Minimum Licence requirement for the Driver is a Speed and current civil drivers licence.
- 1.2.3 Drivers are to be briefed separately to the Event Drivers Briefing and prior to the Activity commencing
- 1.2.4 Passengers are to be briefed immediately before the activity commences.
- 1.2.5 Only vehicles that comply the Motorsport Australia Manual, "Technical Appendix for Rally Cars" are eligible for Sponsor/Official ride activities
- 1.2.6 Vehicles must complete Scrutiny prior to the activity commencing.
- 1.2.7 Clothing and Apparel requirements for this activity is as per Article 6.1.2 of these Supplementary Regulations

# 5 JUDGES OF FACT

#### Article 5.1 - JUDGES OF FACT

In accordance with the NCR the following officials are deemed to be Judges of Fact

- Officials of the event are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Not wearing seat belt, helmet or safety clothing
  - Service Park infringements
  - Shortcutting the course
- Scrutineers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Vehicle in un-roadworthy condition
  - Oil leaking from vehicles
  - Vehicle with accident damage
  - Weight of a vehicle
  - Eligibility of Vehicles
  - Driver Apparel
  - Excessive Noise
- Medical Officers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the Medical condition of
  - Any crew member or team member.
- Speed Monitoring Officials using suitable equipment are deemed to be Judges of Fact to the Speed of a competing vehicle or service vehicle.

# **6 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY**

# Article 6.1 - COMPETITIOR ELIGIBLITY

#### 6.1.1 Licences:

The Driver shall hold, as a minimum, a current Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior Licence, and a civil drivers licence. Minimum age for competitors is 16.

# 6.1.2 Clothing and Apparel:

- 6.1.2.1 Safety helmets, as to AS1698 standard or otherwise to the standard listed in Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are mandatory.
- 6.1.2.2 Clothing of a non-flammable material shall extend from neck to wrist and ankle. Shoes with a leather upper or of a better standard (e.g. racing shoes to FIA standard) must be worn.
- 6.1.2.3 All open Sports and Racing Car drivers must wear goggles or a visor to AS 1609/1981. Goggles with glass lenses, whether laminated or not are unacceptable.
- 6.1.2.4 Driving suits and gloves are encouraged but are not mandatory. All apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

The Organisers reserve the right to review and exclude any Driver who has been identified in the past or during the Event in any officially observed incidents that bring the sport into disrepute, either prior or during the Event. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who harasses or threatens any member of the Event or previous Events.

Any competitor found driving Old Willunga Hill Road at high speed or on the wrong side of the road prior to the running of the event will be excluded from the event.

# 7 VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

#### Article 7.1 - VEHCILE ELIGIBILITY

### Entries will be accepted for the following classes

# **Standard Road Registered Cars**

0 – 1600cc 1600cc – 2000cc 2000cc – 4000cc 4000cc and over Classic – pre 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 4WD Production Vehicles

Standard Road Cars must run on commercial tyres not road legal semi slicks.

Standard Road Cars must have standard turbo and intercooler.

Standard Road Cars will not have a roll cage or canister suspension.

Standard Road Cars will have the same number of seats as standard, and a complete dashboard.

Standard Road Cars must run on fuel rated no higher than 98 octane.

Car can be driven on a permit.

### Modified Vehicles (Modified Registered Vehicles etc.)

0 – 1600cc 1600cc – 2000cc 2000cc – 4000cc 4000cc and over Classic – pre 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 4WD up to 3500cc 4WD over 3500cc

Modified Vehicles can use semi slicks (legal for road use) but **not** racing slicks Can use different turbo and intercooler.

Can have half cage or hoops behind the driver's head

Car can be driven on a permit.

# Race and Rally Cars (this class now requires dedicated competition vehicles to be Registered Vehicles\*)

0 – 1600cc 1600 – 2000cc 2000cc – 4000cc 4000cc and over Classic – pre 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 4WD up to 3500cc 4WD over 3500cc

Race/Rally Cars can use semi slicks (legal for road use) but not racing slicks

Covers any Vehicle with a full roll cage.

Car can be driven on a permit.

# \*\*\*due to SA Police and SA Department for Infrastructure and Transport directive, all competition vehicles must be registered or have a permit\*\*\*

In the case of insufficient entries in any class, i.e. fewer than 3, the class may be amalgamated with the next highest class in the same group (i.e. the class above).

All competing vehicles must comply with <u>SCHEDULE A</u> and <u>SCHEDULE B</u> of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

Cars are expected to be noise tested by the City of Onkaparinga Council during the Event. Please ensure your vehicle is suitably muffled and adheres to the Motorsport Australia Noise Regulations.

All competing vehicles shall carry a properly affixed Fire Extinguisher complying with the provisions of Schedule H of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Tyre Warmers are **prohibited** at this Event.

# **8 DRUGS IN MOTORSPORT**

# Article 8.1 - INTEGRITY

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at <a href="https://www.motorsport.org.au">www.motorsport.org.au</a>.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

# 9 RUNNING OF THE EVENT

### Article 9.1 - RUNNING OF THE EVENT

- 9.1.1 An electronic Drivers briefing will be emailed out to competitors. Please ensure you read it.
- 9.1.2 The Event will start at **0900** hrs on **Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2025** and the last car will finish at approximately **1730** hrs
- 9.1.3 Drivers deemed to have deliberately placed more than one wheel off the Tarmac in an attempt to short cut the course, will receive a penalty for each occurrence of 10 seconds added to their time.
- 9.1.4 Cars may start only at the discretion of the Clerk of Course, and a minimum of a 30 seconds will exist between each start.
- 9.1.5 A top 10 outright shoot-out will commence after the main competition is finished. This is a timed independent to the main competition and will have a separate Trophy and Prize.

# 10 CHANGES CREATED BY CIVIL AUTHORITIES

### Article 10.1 - CHANGES CREATED BY CIVIL AUTHORITIES

10.1.1 These Regulations are issued subject to any provisions made mandatory for the conduct of the Event by the relevant civil authorities between the date of issue of these Regulations and the conduct of the Event.





# 11 ENTRY DETAILS

#### Article 11.1 - ENTRY DETAILS

#### 11.1.1

Completed entries to be performed <u>online</u> on the <u>WOLF Sports Entry System</u> with the appropriate fee (as prescribed in Article 11.1.2 of these Regulations) being paid by credit card on the WOLF Sports site. # 11.1.3

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR or if the number of entries be less than 80 or due to circumstances which result in force majeure. Maximum limit of entries is 140. If the maximum number of entries is received, then a reserve list will be formulated. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt of completed entry forms with correct money.





# 12 SERVICE AND RE-FUELLING

#### Article 12.1 - PIT AREA AND RE-FUELING

- 12.1.1 Re-fuelling can ONLY be carried out within the re-fuel zone within the pit area by the driver or service crews or the Caltex fuel station on Main Road Willunga. No refuelling is to be done in the Main Street of Willunga.
- 12.1.2 The speed of cars in the service park must not exceed 10km/h; offenders will be reported to the Stewards of the Event, who will decide on a penalty.
- 12.1.3 Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

# 13 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

### Article 13.1 - DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

- 13.1.1 Self-Scrutiny will be available for this Event for seasoned hill climb competitors. All documentation will need to be sent to the Event Secretary. Once this is done the Event Secretary will send out self-scrutiny forms for competitors to fill out. Vehicles will be subject to random checks throughout the Event by the Scrutineers. New competitors will need to do a physical scrutineering and documentation as per article 13.1.2 and 13.1.3.
- 13.1.2 Physical Documentation will be available during the following times and must be completed prior to presentation of that vehicle for scrutiny – 1400hrs to 1700hrs on Saturday 13th December or Sunday 14th December from 0700hrs to 0830hrs at Willunga Recreation Park Oval Grounds.
- 13.1.3 New competitor vehicles must be presented for scrutiny either 1400hrs to 1700hrs on Saturday 10th December 2025 or Sunday 14th December 0700hrs to 0830hrs at Willunga Recreation Park Oval Grounds. Vehicles are required to be presented to the scrutineers in a clean state with no significant oil leaks.

13.1.4 All documents MUST be lodged using the Wolf Sports Entry System or by email.

All documents presented must be current & not expire over the duration of the Event.

- 13.1.5 The Driver **MUST** be present at documentation.
- 13.1.6 Any competitor who fails to meet vehicle re-presentation requirements as directed will be refused permission to start the Event. Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

# 14 PROTESTS

# Article 14.1 - PROTESTS

14.1.1 Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with the NCR. Protests relating to the eligibility of an automobile shall be made within 30 minutes of the completion of the competition activities.

# 15 RESULTS

#### Article 15.1 - RESULTS

- 15.1.1 Where a driver has stopped or has been slowed during a heat to render assistance to another crew after an accident or slowed due to a car on the racing line, then that crew will be given a re-run at the most convenient time at the Clerk of Courses discretion.
- 15.1.2 Final Results will be posted on the Ultimate Motorsport Events / Willunga Hillclimb web-site:
