

As I write this we are in the thick of the QJC and I can report it appears everyone is having a good time off the court and trying their absolute hardest on the court. We are all very proud of your efforts.

REPRESENTATIVE SQUASH : Thanks to Cairns Squash and Cairns Junior Squash for supporting the Cairns Juniors who have been selected to represent Queensland and Australia. At the recent club final's presentation President Dean Morzone presented Kurstyn Mather and Josh Penfold \$500 each for their selection to the Australian team to compete at the 2019 World Junior Championships. Along with Kurstyn and Josh, Amy Condon, Sophie Fadaely, Josh Porter and Matthew Finitsis were all presented with \$300 for their selection in the Queensland School team heading to New Zealand in August.

NR JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS : The NR Committee has recently called for clubs to provide their expression of interest to host the 2020 Season of Junior Tournaments.

The Junior Tournament dates are:

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham or Townsville.

Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of the strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

OPEN TOURNAMENTS : 20-21 July - West Squash Club Open Championship - Townsville.

AFFILIATION IS DUE : Particularly important if in January you affiliated for 6 months, your affiliation fees will now be due again. Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months).

Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits - especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity. Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Affiliation status

will be checked prior to all 2019 NR Junior Squash Championships.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

RANKINGS : The Queensland junior rankings were due on 1 June 2019 and were published leading up to the QJC.

The State rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the NR tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

NORTHERN REGION MEETING : Please note a standard item on the NR Meeting Agenda will be a discussion about participation in the NR. This item will be to share ideas about how to increase participation in the NR and how to continue to improve the competition. Please attend the meetings to share your ideas. The more people we have at the table the more ideas we will have to consider. We really need ideas to improve the participation in the region.

The next meeting will be at the 2019 Ingham Junior Championships and the date will be advised.

QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS (QJC) : As mentioned above, the QJC is underway as I'm writing. If you have not finalised your invoice, please do so ASAP. If you need a little more time, this is ok but please contact Moira by email to advise - Moira McGovern at moimac@live.com

2019 Mixed U21 State Champion

Mackay's **Kyle Hoani-Vincent** won the U21 State Title beating Tasmin Swan and **Gavin Condon** in the 3 person Round Robin.



Cairns's **Josh Porter** won the prestigious Peter Nance Achievement Award at the 2019 QJC. The Achievement Award recognises a player's consistent achievement and sportsmanship throughout the entire individual championship.

The Award was named after **Peter Nance** who won the inaugural World Junior Championships in 1980 and 4 Queensland Junior Titles between 1978 and 1980.

Porter had an exceptional championship dropping just one game in the final. Seeded #3 for the Boys U15 event, the talented youngster beat #1 seed Andre Lynn from Victoria 9-11, 11-5, 11-9, 11-9 in a 35 minute final to capture his first State title.






Junior Update



The cold weather hit Mackay with such force the trousers and jumpers were dusted off, but that didn't stop the young ones from participating in the Mackay Winter #1 Mini tournament.



At 0930hrs on the 8th June the courts were alight with laughter and banter. After a warm up the games began with 8 contestants. On the red door court the juniors were having so much fun it was hard to determine whether the 2 players were playing their match or it was conversational banter or a competition to see who could laugh loudest. The noise that was coming from the court almost took the roof off!

A huge welcome to the new Juniors to the competition scene: Sage White and Jackson Chapman - their enthusiasm to improve is outstanding. The participants achieved the following points:

2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



Our aim is to recognise as many NR juniors as we can with the **RedStar** Performance Recognition System. **Every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised.** Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.



Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2018 it is still a 2019 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2019 NR Player of the Year Award**. A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9, U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
