ABOUT THE COMMUNITY CHALLENGE

What is the Ausbuild Community Challenge?

The Ausbuild Community Challenge, presented by Moreton Daily and proudly supported by Ausbuild, brings together 20 not-for-profit Community Teams and 20 Corporate Teams for a city-wide fundraising and team challenge.

As a Corporate Team, you'll be paired with a Community Team to help raise funds, boost awareness, and compete in a series of fun, team-based challenges. Together, you'll drive raffle ticket sales, promote silent auction bids, and earn points through creative, physical, and chance-based games during the lead-up and Challenge Afternoon.

If you already have a not-for-profit or charity you'd like to support, let us know and we'll help facilitate

the partnership. Otherwise, we'll match you with a Community Team that aligns with your values.

All 20 Community Teams will receive a share of the guaranteed \$50,000 prize pool, with final amounts determined by team performance. With your support, we're aiming to raise \$100,000 or more, every dollar of which goes directly back to participating community organisations.

Corporate Teams won't take home any money BUT you will have a great experience, make a difference and the winning Corporate Team will be awarded a trophy and serious bragging rights!





ABOUT THE COMMUNITY CHALLENGE

How do teams win money?

- Points are earned through pre-event challenges and attendance
- Points are also awarded during the Challenge Afternoon via physical, mental, creative and chance-based games
- All points you earn will go directly to your matched Community Team, helping them climb the leaderboard and secure a bigger share of the prize pool
- The final score determines your position on the leaderboard
- Prize money is distributed via a tiered system, the higher you place, the more you receive
- All 20 Community Teams will receive funding, regardless of final placement

Note for Corporate Teams

While Corporate Teams won't receive prize money, you'll gain something even better - the chance to make a real impact, raise funds for the community, strengthen your team, and be part of an unforgettable experience.

The highest-scoring Corporate Team will walk away with a trophy, recognition across Moreton Daily's platforms, and serious bragging rights.
