



ROLE of GAME STEWARD

The primary role of a Game Steward is to assist NWJSA in controlling and monitoring the behaviour of their own players and spectators and to assist the Referee.

Game Stewards are considered to be Team Officials.

- The Game Steward is to always wear the hi-vis vest provided by NWJSA while undertaking the role.
- Prior to the commencement of the game, the Game Steward should introduce themselves to the Referee.
- If a person is appointed as a Game Steward, this is the only role that they are to undertake during the game.
- While acting in the role of Game Steward, the person is not a spectator and consequently should not question the decisions of the Referee.

Other duties Include:

- Assisting N.W.J.S.A. Referees and Official when requested.
- Keeping people away from behind the goals.
- Keeping people back from the side lines.
- Ensuring their teams spectators abide by the Spectators Code of Conduct.
- A Game Steward should at no time become involved in any verbal or physical altercations.
- A Game Steward should not approach opposition supporters or officials, this should be undertaken by the opposing team's Ground Steward.
- If a Game Steward does encounter any issues or concerns, they are to inform and provide information to their School Delegate
