## Parent/Carer and Spectator Code of Conduct

As a Parent/Carer or Spectator I will:

1. Respect the decisions of Match Officials and teach children to do the same.
2. Do not enter the field of play unless prompted by Match or NWJSA official.
3. Respect the rights and dignity of all participants, players, coaches, officials, volunteers and other spectators at all times.
4. Contribute to a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment for all participants, players, coaches, match officials, officials, volunteers and other spectators. Set an example by always behaving well, modelling positive behaviours of fair play and respect. Applaud good play by all players and teams.
5. Comply with child safeguarding requirements and directions from Association officials and volunteers. Not leave my child or a child in my care, at an NWJSA venue, unattended or unsupervised
6. Social Media and Online do not publish comments, images or material that is abusive, defamatory, harmful, discriminatory or breaches privacy of all participants, players, coaches, match officials, officials, volunteers and other spectators.
7. Never ridicule, criticise or unduly scold a child for making a mistake. Focus on playing the game and doing their best is what they should be trying to achieve. Take the emphasis away from winning.
8. Encourage children to participate, if they are interested. However, if a child is not willing, not force them.
9. Refrain from engaging in violence, discrimination, harassment or abuse in any form against any person, whether they be spectators, team officials, coaches, match officials, officials, volunteers or players.
10. Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials, match officials, volunteers and administrators.
11. Do not stand next to or behind the goal. Do not enter the field of play during a game unless prompted by the match official.
12. Do not approach coaches, match officials, officials, volunteers, other spectators in a confrontational manner
13. Comply with all Association rules and regulations, Member Protection Policy, Child Safeguarding Policy, Code of Conducts and all policies. Leave the venue immediately if directed by an Association Official for reasons relating to safety, behaviour or in breach of the Association Policies.
14. Provide a drink bottle with water and encourage players to drink plain water before, during and immediately after sport participation.
15. Refrain from providing lollies for sport participation. Instead, provide fresh snacks, or oranges for half time or designated break.
