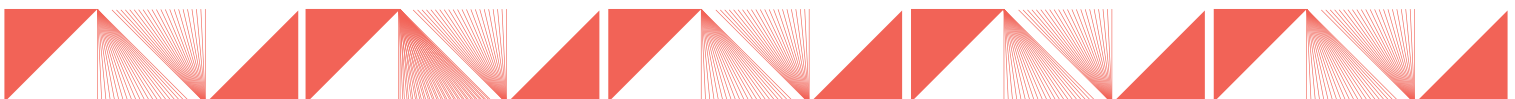

Every school that offers vocational programmes of learning to their students has a potential Award winner. To guide your nomination, you may want to consider a holistic assessment of the following factors: Please use the following criteria to guide your nomination of a student:

- Achievement of or on track to achieve NCEA Level 2
- Participation in Trades Academy, Secondary Tertiary Programmes or Gateway Programmes
- Achievement of or on track to achieve a Vocational Pathways Award (Creative Industries, Primary Industries, Service Industries, Social and Community Services, Manufacturing and Technology, Construction and Infrastructure)
- Success in vocationally-oriented subjects offered by the school
- Participation in available courses or programmes that contribute to success in their chosen pathway e.g. driver's license courses
- Evidence of a clear pathway from schooling into further vocational education, training or employment.
