The aforementioned colt was admitted to Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre on Wednesday, 3 June 2020 for treatment of osteochondral changes of the left hock as detected on screening radiography. In order to maximise any future racing potential it was advised to surgically explore the joint and treat any lesions as appropriate. A medium sized osteochondral fragment was removed from the joint - medial malleolus.

The colt had an uneventful recovery and no complications were noted during the post operative period.

Images were obtained on Tuesday, 2 February 2021 showed that the response to surgery has been very good and the horse should be considered a normal risk for purchase and racing.
This report does not constitute a full appraisal of the horse for sale and is limited to an opinion of the left hock radiographs only.
