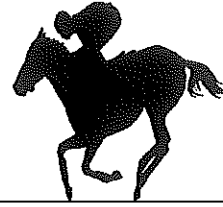

RE: 'Girls Hav Time' yearling standardbred filly

On 17 September 2020 'Girls Hav Time' had arthroscopic surgery on the left hock for treatment of OCD.

At surgery a total of seven varying sized fragments; three free floating and four adhered to synovium were removed from the tibiotarsal joint. These had originated from the apex of the lateral trochlear which was curetted to healthy bone. She recovered well from surgery.

On 17 December 2020 follow up x rays were taken of the left hock. These x-ray showed a small approx 1mm by 2mm lightly osseous fragment on the medial aspect of the joint. This fragment is most likely adhered to the medial synovial lining and I believe it is of questionable clinical significance.
