EXPLANATION OF PEDIGREES & BRANDS

The criteria for the use of Black Type in pedigrees is as follows:

BOLD FACE CAPITALS indicate the horse is a Group One winner, \$100,000 stakes earner or 2.00 winning performer.

Bold Face Ordinary indicates that a horse is a Group Two or Group Three race winner, or a Group One placegetter.

Freeze Brands

New Zealand use the "T.V.I." system of freeze brands which are applied as a two line brand to the neck to identify each horse. The top line is three symbols - two to denote the year of birth and the other, the letter "Z" to indicate the country of origin (New Zealand). The bottom line is a four digit registration number.

The bottom line of the freeze brand (four digit registration number) of each Lot appears at the top of the pedigree page.
