Car Parking Fact Sheet

Port Dock Railway Line Project

The South Australian Government has committed \$51 million for the Port Dock Railway Line Project. The project will re-establish the spur line, construct a new train station and bus interchange.

The Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance is delivering this project.

Changes during construction

During construction, some temporary extended closures of the car park will be needed. We will provide advanced notice before any temporary closures.

We anticipate car park works will be finished in mid- 2024, weather permitting.

Construction staging

We have planned the works to minimise impact to car park users as much as possible.

Stage 1: car park works and temporary closure

From Monday 29 January 2024, weather permitting the whole car park will be closed for approximately eight weeks.

Advanced notice signage advising of the closure date have been placed in the car park. Car park upgrade works during the temporary closure will include:

- removal of existing kerb and vegetation;
- installation of new underground services (drainage and power);
- construction of new kerb;
- placement of asphalt; and
- line marking.

We will also set up a small project compound within the existing car park on Lipson Street.

Stage 2: sections of car park reopening, March 2024

In late March 2024, the car park will be reopened to the public with some reduced capacity. This will provide some parking spaces for the public, while the project continues construction of the bus interchange.

For safety reasons the outer edge of the car park will be fenced off.

Stage 3: final car park works complete, mid-2024


Ongoing minor works will continue to be undertaken in some areas of the car park to complete the finishing works.

The car park will provide 94 parking spaces, including four accessible parking spaces.
