GOLDEN GROVE PARK 'N' RIDE

Asphalt works

As part of the Golden Grove Park 'n' Ride Project, additional asphalt resurfacing works will be carried out on The Grove Way, Golden Grove.

Upcoming works

From Tuesday, 22 November 2022, works will commence to remove and reinstate the asphalt on The Grove Way, between Adey Place and the northern Park 'n' Ride access road and are expected to take up to four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Works will occur as follows:

- Day works between 9am and 5pm from Tuesday, 22 November to Friday, 26 November 2022.
- Night works between the hours of 7pm and 6am, Sunday 28 November to Thursday, 8 December 2022 (finishing at 6am Friday morning). Please note there will be no night works on Friday or Saturday nights.
- Day works between 9am and 5pm from Monday, 12 December to Friday, 16 December 2022. between 9am and 5pm.

All works will be subject to weather conditions and may be rescheduled if required. Every effort will be made to complete the works as safely and efficiently as possible.

Works will include removal and reinstatement of asphalt, traffic signal detection loops, pram ramps and road line marking. You may also notice some odor which is common when asphalting works are underway.

Traffic changes

To safely undertake these works, lane and speed restrictions will be in place.

Marie Clarke Drive will be intermittently closed at the junction with The Grove Way between 7pm and 6am for the duration of the night works, weather permitting. Detours will be in place via Bicentennial Drive. The Grove Way will remain open. See map overleaf for more details.

Vehicle access to and from the Park 'n' Ride will be maintained. Between 7pm and 6am during the night works, access will be via the Helping Hand Aged Care access road. See map overleaf for more details.

Access to local businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Temporary changes to public transport and bus stop

To enable these works to be undertaken safely, bus stops 62A east and west and 62 northeast will be intermittently closed at night during the works. Advanced notice will be provided at the bus stops prior to this closure occurring.

During the closure of Marie Clarke Drive at the junction of The Grove Way, Adelaide Metro buses will be detoured via Bicentennial Drive and will not service the bus stops on Marie Clarke Drive. Please contact Adelaide Metro for more information on 1300 311 108 or visit adelaidemetro.com.au


