

WORKS NOTIFICATION

OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

Ovingham Railway Station night works Saturday, 29 October to Monday, 31 October 2022

Dear residents,

We recently provided notification about night works at the Ovingham Railway Station. The activities included essential track maintenance works which involve compacting the ballast stones under the railway lines through a process called 'tamping'.

Due to machinery issues, we were unable to complete the tamping as previously advised. Works are now rescheduled to be undertaken on **Saturday, 29 October and Sunday, 30 October 2022, between the hours of 1am and 5am each day. Please note that train services will not be impacted.**

Pedestrian and cyclist access changes

As part of the works the pedestrian railway crossing, north of the station at McEwin Street and Avenue Road will be closed **from 1am Saturday, 29 October until midday Monday, 31 October 2022.**

The crossing south of the station at Torrens Road will remain open and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage.

Noise, dust, vibration and light spill

During tamping works, you may experience high-level vibration and hear noise from rail equipment, machinery and vehicle movements.

It is important to note that experiencing vibration does not mean damage will occur to your property. The generated vibration levels are considered too low in magnitude to cause structural damage.

Dust monitors will be in place to ensure the project meets regulatory standards whilst noise and vibration will be monitored in strategic locations to ensure the project does not exceed compliance levels.

Lighting towers will be used during these works.

Access to residential properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during works.
