

## **OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT**

### **Drainage works**

#### **September – October 2021**

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project, underground drainage is currently being installed. This is occurring in various locations within the project construction area on both the eastern and western sides of the railway line, alongside Torrens Road and Churchill Road. These works are expected to be completed in March 2022.

To safely facilitate these works across Torrens Road and Churchill Road, road closures and traffic detours are required until mid-October 2021.

**To minimise the impact to road users, works are underway at night between 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday, weather permitting.**

### **What to expect during night works**

#### *Traffic changes*

The following changed traffic conditions are currently in place while the work is underway:

- eastbound lanes of Torrens Road, between Churchill Road and Exeter Terrace, are closed between **7pm and 6am until Thursday, 14 October 2021, weather permitting;**

Detours are in place to direct motorists, suggested detour routes include:

- **detours for light vehicles** via Hawker Street and Chief Street; and
- **detours for heavy vehicles** via Park Terrace, Port Road and the North-South Motorway.

Additional traffic changes, including lane and speed restrictions, will be in place along Torrens Road, Churchill Road, and intersecting side streets during the work.

### **Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained.**

Adelaide Metro buses will be detoured at night during the closures. Advance signage will be in place at bus stops to advise passengers of the detours.

### *Noise and vibration*

Excavators, tippers, saw cutters, compaction equipment and lighting towers will be used during these works. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the works will be managed to minimise disruption as much as practically possible.
