

OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

Drainage works - Update

October 2021

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project, underground drainage is currently being installed. This is occurring in various locations within the project construction area on both the eastern and western sides of the railway line, alongside Torrens Road and Churchill Road. These works are expected to be completed in March 2022.

Until late October 2021, road closures and traffic detours across Torrens Road and Churchill Road **will continue at night between 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday, weather permitting.**

What to expect during night works

Traffic changes

Eastbound lanes of Torrens Road, between Churchill Road and Exeter Terrace, are closed between **7pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday.**

Detours are in place to direct motorists, suggested detour routes include:

- **detours for light vehicles** via Hawker Street and Chief Street; and
- **detours for heavy vehicles** via Park Terrace, Port Road and the North-South Motorway.

Additional traffic changes, including lane and speed restrictions, will be in place along Torrens Road, Churchill Road, and intersecting side streets.
