OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

UPDATED COMPLETION DATE FOR MAJOR STAGING WORKS TO OPEN NEW BRIDGE

The Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTP Alliance) commenced undertaking major staging works on Sunday, 29 May 2022, to switch traffic onto the new Torrens Road bridge.

Due to extreme wet weather, these works are now scheduled to be completed by **5am Friday, 17 June 2022, weather permitting**. Should this date change, the PTP Alliance will provide advance notice.

The works will continue to require traffic changes including speed and lane restrictions, road closures and detours until **5am Friday, 17 June 2022, weather permitting**.

The works will continue to be undertaken continuously for this period, during the day and night shifts.

At the completion of this work, traffic will be switched onto the new Torrens Road bridge. Please see the map over the page for the new traffic arrangement that will be in place from 5am Friday, 17 June 2022, weather permitting.

We thank everyone for their patience and understanding while we undertake these important infrastructure works.

Changed traffic conditions

To safely undertake these works, changed traffic conditions will remain in place, including temporary road closures, speed and lane restrictions.

Traffic management and detours

Detours will be in place to direct motorists. Please note that traffic restrictions on Churchill Road will change from 5am Saturday, 11 June 2022, weather permitting, with traffic able to turn right from Torrens Road into Churchill Road. Please see the maps over the page for traffic detour information.

Please continue to plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and direction of traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Temporary pedestrian and cyclist changes

The works continue to require temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours. Please follow the site signage and observe the direction of traffic controllers.

Access to properties

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout the works, wherever possible. Please continue to support local businesses.

Noise and vibration


Trucks, concrete saws, excavators, tippers, concrete pumps, compaction equipment and lighting towers will continue to be used during these works.

Asphalt works will also be undertaken and there may be some odour associated with these works.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be
