# **Torrens Road Bicycle Lane Extension and Road Surface Improvements**

The PTP Alliance is delivering a bicycle lane extension and road surface improvements on Torrens Road as part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project.

## **What is being delivered?**

To improve cyclist safety, we will be installing new bicycle lanes on Torrens Road between Chief Street and Mais Street (outbound lane) and between Coglein Street and Chief Street (citybound lane). The existing bicycle lane will also be repaved.

Road surface improvement works will also occur along Torrens Road, between Chief Street and John Hindmarsh Frontage.

Works will include:

- site establishment works, locating of underground services and set up of temporary fencing and road barriers;
- relocation of utility services;
- widening of the northern side of Torrens Road;
- road resurfacing;
- installation of new kerbing, footpaths and driveways;

- road and bicycle lane line marking;
- installation of road signage; and
- landscaping works.

## **How will the bicycle lanes operate?**

The bicycle lanes will be shown by painted lines and bicycle symbols along Torrens Road. Green lanes will be used at intersecting side roads.

The bicycle lanes will operate during peak travel times to allow parking outside of peak times for local businesses and residents.

Operation times of the bicycle lanes will be specified on road signage:

- 4.30pm to 6pm Monday to Friday outbound; and
- 7.30am to 9am Monday to Friday citybound.

## Timing of works

Construction of the bicycle lanes and road surface improvements will commence in September 2022, and are expected to be completed early 2023, weather permitting.

These works will be undertaken in three stages:

**Stage 1:** middle section of Torrens Road

**Stage 2:** northern side of Torrens Road

**Stage 3:** southern side of Torrens Road

Please see enclosed Torrens Road bicycle lane extension and pavement rehabilitation work stages map.

The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, from 6am to 6pm.

If significant lane and speed restrictions are required, works will be undertaken at night, Sunday to Thursday, from 7pm to 6am. Advance notice of night works will be provided to properties within close proximity of the construction area.

In preparation for the bicycle lanes and road surface improvement works, the installation of the Common Services Trench (holding key utility services including lighting, communications and power) and relocation of utility services will continue during August and early September 2022.

Contraflow of traffic (placing all traffic on one side of the road to allow traffic to continue to travel in both directions) and temporary side road closures will be required at times. Advance notice will be provided for any temporary traffic diversions.

Please observe speed limits and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Temporary speed, lane, turning movements and parking restrictions will be required while this work is

undertaken, as well as short-term localised road closures.

The PTP Alliance will work closely with residents, businesses and council to communicate changes and ensure that impacts will be minimised as much as possible.

## Temporary pedestrian, cyclist and public transport changes

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the work site and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage.

Public transport services will also be temporarily impacted along Torrens Road from mid-August 2022.

Changes to bus stops and timetables will be placed on the Adelaide Metro website closer to the time of the works. [www.adelaidemetro.com.au](http://www.adelaidemetro.com.au). Advance notice signage will also be placed at bus stops to advise passengers of changes.
