OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

OVINGHAM RAILWAY STATION UPGRADE

The PTP Alliance is delivering an upgrade of the Ovingham Railway Station as part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project.

As part of the upgrade, night works will be undertaken in the rail corridor at the Ovingham Railway Station over four weekends in September and October 2022. Public transport services will also be temporarily impacted to safely facilitate these upgrade works. Please read on for more information.

Activities will include:

- concrete works;
- installation of underground drainage;
- installation of station shelters;
- painting of platforms and line marking;
- asphalt removal;
- installation of light poles and signage; and
- installation of throw screens on the Torrens Road bridge (directly over the rail corridor).

Essential track maintenance works will also be undertaken during this time. The works will involve compacting the ballast stones under the railway lines through a process called 'tamping'.

What to expect

Timing of works

Works will be undertaken at night during the below weekends.

- From 9pm Saturday, 17 September to 5am Sunday, 18 September 2022
 From 9pm Sunday, 18 September to 4am Monday, 19 September 2022
- From 9pm Saturday, 24 September to 5am Sunday, 25 September 2022
 From 9pm Sunday, 25 September to 4am Monday, 26 September 2022
- From 9pm Saturday, 8 October to 5am Sunday, 9 October 2022
 From 9pm Sunday, 9 October to 4am Monday, 10 October 2022
- From 9pm Saturday, 15 October to 5am Sunday, 16 October 2022
 From 9pm Sunday, 16 October to 4am Monday, 17 October 2022

Access changes

Access to residential properties will be maintained. If any access restrictions are necessary, you will be notified in advance by the project team.

Public transport changes

Public transport services will be temporarily impacted.

To safely facilitate upgrade works at Ovingham Railway Station, the Gawler rail line will be temporarily closed in both directions between Adelaide Railway Station and Mawson Interchange from 9pm until the last service each Saturday and Sunday night from 17 September to 16 October 2022 (excluding the October long weekend on 1 -3 October 2022).

Trains will resume normal running from first service Sunday and Monday mornings respectively throughout the partial closure period.

During these partial closures, Gawler rail line train services will continue to run between Mawson Interchange and Gawler Central Railway Station. Substitute buses will operate between Adelaide Railway Station and Mawson Interchange.

Advance notice signage will be in place at railway stations to advise passengers of the changes.

Pedestrian and cyclist access changes

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the works site. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Noise, dust, vibration and light spill

Trucks, concrete pumps, excavators, paint preparation equipment, vacuum trucks and lighting towers will be used during these works. Some noise, dust and vibration disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed.

Dust monitors will be in use to ensure the project meets regulatory standards whilst noise and vibration will be monitored in strategic locations to ensure the project does not exceed compliance levels.

During tamping works, you may experience high-level vibration and hear noise from rail equipment, machinery and vehicle movements.

It is important to note that experiencing vibration does not mean damage will occur to your property. The generated vibration levels are considered too low in magnitude to cause structural damage.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during works.
