OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

UTILITY SERVICE RELOCATIONS

The Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTP Alliance) is removing the rail level crossing on Torrens Road, Ovingham to improve travel times, connectivity, and safety for all road and rail users. The \$196 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project, works to relocate SA Water and SA Power Networks services will be undertaken across Torrens Road, between West Street and Coglein Street. These works will be undertaken from **5am Saturday, 5 November until 7pm Sunday, 6 November 2022**.

Please note that works are weather permitting and if there are any delays, we will provide advance notice.

There are no planned interruptions to water or power services during these works.

What to expect

Traffic changes

To safely undertake these works, lane closures and lane and speed restrictions will be in place.

Detours will be in place to direct motorists. Although the works are being undertaken during the daytime, traffic restrictions will remain in place for the whole weekend.

Please see the map over the page for traffic detour information during these works.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and direction of traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained. In the event that access restrictions are necessary, you will be notified in advance by the project team.

Public transport changes

Public transport services will be temporarily impacted along Torrens Road.

Adelaide Metro buses will be detoured during the closures. Advance notice signage will be in place at bus stops to advise passengers of the detours.

Pedestrian and cyclist access changes

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Trucks, concrete saws, excavators, tippers, compaction equipment and vac trucks will be used during these works.
