OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

SA WATER MAIN RELOCATIONS

The Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTP Alliance) is removing the rail level crossing on Torrens Road, Ovingham to improve travel times, connectivity, and safety for all road and rail users. The \$196 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal SA Water main relocations will be undertaken along Torrens Road, between Chief Street and Picton Street from **7pm Sunday, 22 May to 6am Thursday, 26 May**.

SA Water will provide at least four days advance notice for any temporary planned water outages. For queries about water outages, please call SA Water on **1300 729 283**.

What to expect

Hours of work

Works will be undertaken between **7pm and 6am daily from Sunday, 22 May to 6am Thursday, 26 May**.

Traffic changes

To safely undertake these works, lane and speed restrictions will be in place. Torrens Road will remain open. Some local detours will be in place for part of the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained. In the event that access restrictions are necessary, you will be notified in advance by the project team.

There is no change to public transport services.

Pedestrian and cyclist access changes

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Noise, vibration, and light spill

Some noise and vibration disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the works will be managed to minimise disruption as much as practically possible.


Concrete saw cutting and compaction of road material will be required. Rock breaking machinery will also be required at times and will only be used up until 10pm, unless otherwise advised.

Temporary light towers will be used during night works.
