PORT DOCK RAILWAY LINE PROJECT

RAIL MAINTENANCE WORKS

JUNE 2023

The South Australian Government has committed \$51 million for the Port Dock Railway Line Project. The Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance comprising of McConnell Dowell, Arup and Mott MacDonald, together with the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, will deliver this project.

The project will re-establish the spur line, construct a new train station and bus interchange. It is expected to support 100 full time equivalent jobs per year averaged over the life of the construction period.

While the Outer Harbor and Grange rail lines are closed for planned maintenance, site preparation and rail maintenance works will be undertaken for the Port Dock Railway Line Project within the railway corridor, between the Alberton Railway Station and the South Australian Aviation Museum.

These works will occur on Sunday, 11 June and Monday, 12 June, between 9am and 5pm and from Tuesday, 13 June to Sunday, 18 June 2023, between 7am and 5.30pm.

Key Activities

Key activities will include:

- concrete barriers and rail infrastructure materials will be transported to site and temporarily stored along the railway corridor, adjacent to Russell Street, Rosewater;
- installation of concrete barriers adjacent the Outer Harbor line;
- track configuration and signal works;
- removal and reinstatement of rail and sleepers to allow ballast stones to be renewed; and
- welding of rail.

How will these works affect me?

Construction noise

You may hear noise from delivery trucks, machinery placing concrete barriers in place, grinding and cutting of rail and excavation of ballast stones, use of tamper equipment and soil material.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during works.

Public transport changes

Works will be undertaken during a planned closure of the of the Outer Harbor and Grange lines. Substitute buses will be operating during this time, for further information please visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au
