OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

Traffic changes at Myrtle Street, Prospect June 2021

The Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTP Alliance) is removing the level crossing on Torrens Road, Ovingham, to improve travel times, connectivity, and safety for all road and rail users. The \$196 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

As outlined in the 'Traffic Switch' fact sheet, this first traffic switch, which will be in place from 5am Monday, 28 June 2021, into the first quarter of 2022, and will require temporary changes to vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist detours, and bus stop locations.

Bedford Avenue is identified as one of the alternate routes.

To facilitate the alternate route, the right turn from Churchill Road will be extended. This will require the right turns into and out of Myrtle Street from Churchill Road to be temporarily removed, from late June 2021.

Left in and left out turns will still be permitted. Please see map over the page for alternative right turns.

The right turn movements at the Myrtle Street and Churchill Road junction will be reinstated later in the project.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

We appreciate your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
